What is Milad un Nabi?

The word Milad has been derived from the Arabic word "Viladut", which means birth. Milad is a word which signifies the place & time of birth. In the light of shariah, Milad is to remember the events, which took place @ the time & birth of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (P.B.U.H.).

In a lengthy tradition which is divided into six independent thoughts, Allah (SWT) has stated the following to His Prophet in a Hadith-e-

Qudsi: *“My servant! There are six things which are from me while six things which are from you.”*

The Paradise (Jannat) is from me while the obedience is from you.

When we look at the description in the Quran of those who reside in Paradise and the traditions of the Ahlul Bayt, we see that one of the things required from us is absolute and total obedience to the orders of Allah and those whom He has commanded us to follow – the Prophet, Imams and as an extension our Marja Taqlid who interprets the laws of the Quran and Sunnah for us. Truthfully, the deal which we strike with Allah is very simple – all we need to do is follow His order – which is nothing more than obeying common sense and logic – and we are granted Paradise from Him! A majority, if not all of the rules of Islam can be understood using simple logic and common sense and nothing is mystical or too ‘deep’ that we cannot understand and practice it. The faith of Islam is easy to follow since it is based on the innate traits of all human beings and a set of ethical and morals values which all of humanity share.
